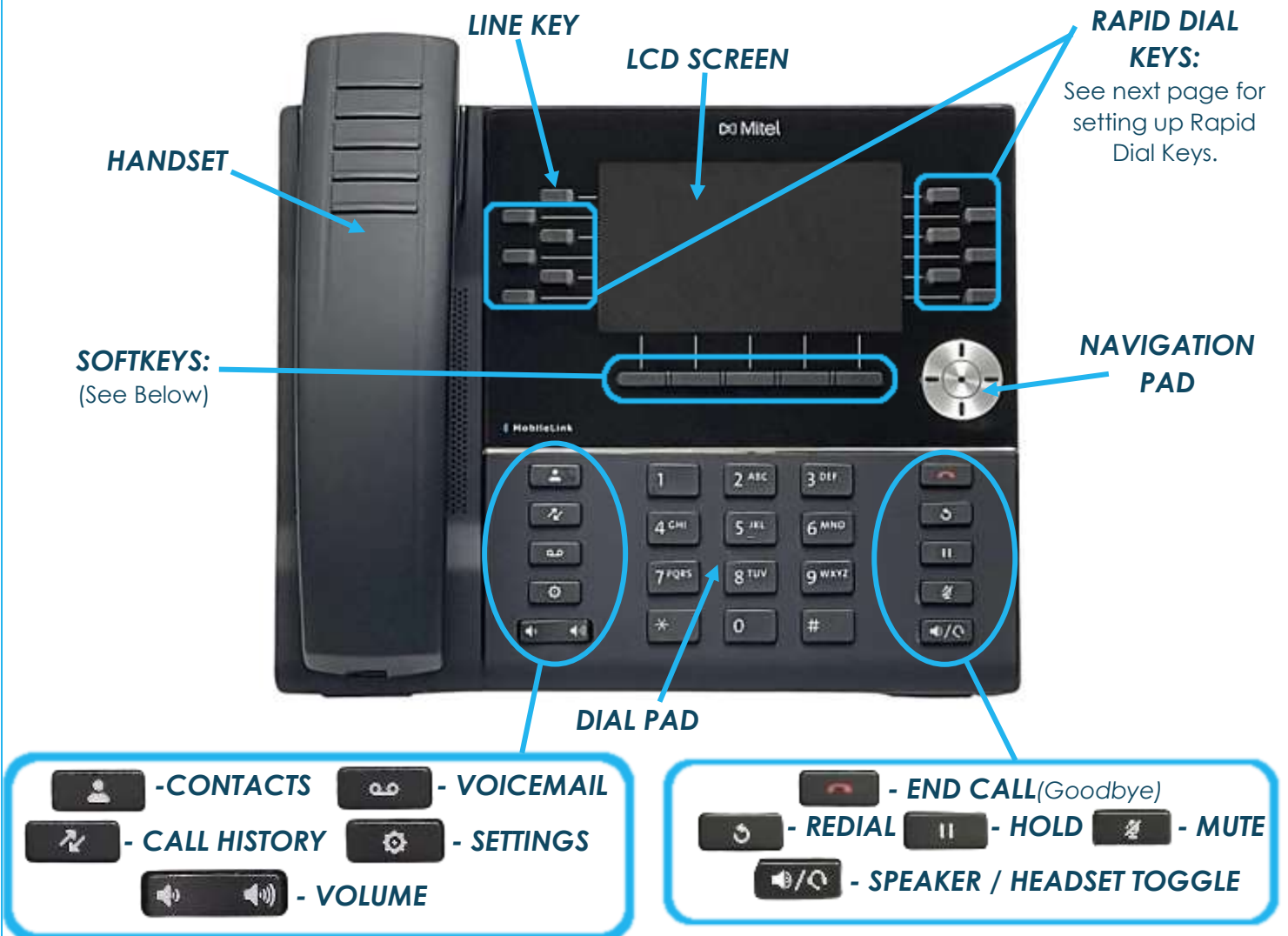




MiVoice 6930 IP Phone

Transferring a Call:

- During a call, press the **Xfer** softkey. This places the active caller on hold.
- Enter the recipient's number (*extension or phone#*)

Blind Transfer — Press the **Xfer** softkey again or hang up the handset to complete transfer.

Attended Transfer — Wait for an answer, consult, and then press the **Xfer** softkey or hang up the handset to complete an attended transfer.

Forwarding Calls:

- Press the  icon on desk phone to access your **Settings**.
- Select **Call Forward** from menu options.



Use your Navigation Pad to cycle through and select windows.



Enter the number you would like calls forwarded to.

(If you want different numbers to forward calls when you **MISS** or are **BUSY** on phone, enter in fields below **ALL**.)

Activate "**ON**"

Select how many times you want desk phone to ring before it forwards call.

Select "**SAVE**" softkey to activate call forwarding.

Setting External Contact Speed Dials:


Use your Navigation Pad to cycle through and select windows.



On desk phone's home screen, long press an unassigned *Rapid Dial* Key for (4) seconds.



Using the phone's Keypad, enter the **name** of the contact.
